

Gauge: 3.75 sts/in
Needles: Size 9(5.5mm) or size to get gauge
Yarn: Sand from Classic Elite, 100% cotton, 50g/77 yds or nylon eyelash and cotton together or yarn to get gauge
Sizes: Approximately 8", but not square
Supplies: Tapestry ndl, crochet hook, markers

Using size 9(5.5mm) ndls, CO 43 sts.
 Row 1 (RS): K19 sts, PM, k5, PM, k19
 Row 2 and even rows: Knit
 Row 3: K17, SSK, k5, k2tog, k17.
 PM to mark RS.
 Row 5: Knit to 2 sts before marker, SSK, k5, k2tog, knit
 Rep Even and Rows 5 a total of 15 times, ending with Even Row. 9 sts
 Remove markers on last row.
 Row 7: K1, SSK, k3, k2tog, k1. 7 sts
 Row 9: K1, SSK, k1, k2tog, k1. 5 sts
 Row 11: K1, SK2P, k1. 3 sts
 Row 12: SK2P

Work in ends.
 To omit loop, cut yarn and pull through the last st.

Techniques and Abbreviations

k2tog

Put right ndl into 2nd st, then 1st st on left ndl as if to knit and knit as one stitch.

Loop

Use a crochet hook to chain 10 from last st. Without turning work, go into next-to-last chain, *pull yarn through that loop then through both loops on hook; rep from * in each chain. At last chain, go into chain and knitting and make final loop; cut yarn and pull through final loop.

SK2P

Slip 1 st to right ndl as to purl, knit 2 together, use left ndl tip to pass the slipped st over the k2tog and off right ndl.

SSK

*Slip 1st st to right ndl as to knit, slip next st as to purl. Use left ndl and go through the fronts of the 2 unworked sts, keeping left ndl in front, and knit those 2 sts together.
