

**Gauge:** 6 sts/in = 24 sts/4"  
**Needles:** Size 5(3.75mm) ndls OR size to obtain gauge  
**Yarn:** Fixation from Cascade yarns, 97.3% cotton, 1.7% elastic, 50g/100 yds  
**Amount:** Partial ball  
**Size:** One size (elastic yarn allows for size variations)  
**Supplies:** Tapestry ndl

### Willy Warmer

#### Body:

Using size 3(3.25mm) dpns and long-tail cast on, CO24 sts.  
PM and join without twisting.

Rnd 1: \*K1, p1; rep from \*

Rep Rnd 1 a total of 4 times.

Rnd 2: Knit

Rep Rnd 2 until piece measures desired length from beg.

#### End:

Dec Rnd 1: \*K2, k2tog, k2; rep from \*. 20 sts

Even Rnds: Knit

Dec Rnd 3: \*K1, k2tog, k2; rep from \*. 16 sts

Dec Rnd 5: \*K2tog, k1; rep from \*. 12 sts

Dec Rnd 7: (K2tog) 6 times. 6 sts

Cut yarn.

Use tapestry ndl to run tail through remaining sts and pull closed.
